

Each production begins with the script, exploring what the story is, how to tell it, & why. Our concept centered on the fabric of storytelling, reflected in design details like Milky White made of books, a library for the setting & fabric printed with script text in every costume!

A highlight of every season! Our Youth Artist Project pairs high school students with professional theatre artists & educators for hands-on, real-world experiences. Together, they bring a short musical to life with an all-youth cast to introduce our youngest audiences to the magic of theatre. Whether or not they pursue careers in the arts, students attain skills in teamwork, leadership & collaboration that benefit them wherever they go.

The first in the state! Thanks to an early offer to apply for a license to produce Waitress, GREAT was the first of four Minnesota theatres to produce this show last season! The success of past productions, thanks to community support of GREAT shows at the Paramount, was a key role in us receiving this offer & we are grateful.

A stage full of possibility! To give more youth the chance to shine, we double cast the munchkins. Reflecting on their role, one wise munchkin shared, "In The Wizard of Oz, Glinda says to Dorothy, 'You've always had the power my dear, you just had to learn it for yourself.' GREAT helped me see my power and showed me that I'm important."

The surprise hit of the season! This show wasn't a top pick in our season planning survey, but we believed in its message & our community reacted with unexpected enthusiasm. Featuring the hits of Elvis, this show marked our first weekday matinee for adults. Busloads of seniors filled the Paramount on a Thursday afternoon, celebrating nostalgia of 50s rock 'n' roll while connecting with a fresh story of love, freedom & individuality.

**Double the cast, double the charm!** With only six roles & no ensemble parts for understudies, we chose to double cast *Steel Magnolias*. This gave 12 women the chance to step into Truvy's Beauty Salon & offered flexibility for cast members to step away from a performance & take care of themselves while still delivering a high-quality performance every night.
