Position Summary

As a carpenter, you'll play a vital role in bringing the artistic vision of a production to life!

You'll get to build, install, and maintain scenic elements, sets, and props - on budget and within tight timelines. Working closely with other production team members, you'll interpret technical drawings, utilize woodworking tools, and ensure the structural integrity and safety of scenic pieces, with a focus on quality craftsmanship and efficiency.

All employees are expected to champion and support Equity, Diversity and Inclusion work.

Job Functions

As Carpenter, you'll get to:

- Construct and install various scenic elements, platforms, sets, and props according to design plans and specifications
- Organize and maintain a safe shop space
- Collaborate with other production team members to understand project requirements and timelines
- Interpret technical drawings and blueprints to accurately fabricate and assemble scenic elements
- Ensure structural integrity and safety of all constructed scenic pieces, adhering to industry standards and regulations
- Shape and manipulate materials by sawing, drilling, routing, and sanding
- Assist with load-ins, strikes, and other technical aspects of productions, including transportation and installation of scenic pieces
