Job Functions

- Work with a variety of students from varied backgrounds and abilities
- Intentionally develop positive relationships with all campers
- Observe, collaborate with, and learn from GREAT Summer Teaching Artists
- Support implementation of daily activities and games
- Contribute to establishing a culture that is creative, engaging, and safe
- Utilize theatre arts as a tool to educate students in intellectual, social, and emotional capacities
