Please prepare the following section - provide a unique character voice for each speaker (it's radio!). Everyone will perform this section of the script by themselves.

LEARY: Hey! Who's that?
CRAIGIN: Bassick? Is that you hiding over there?
BASSICK: That's right, Craigin. Is Leary here?
LEARY: Yes, sir. I got here early to make sure it was clear.
BASSICK: McTague? Has anyone seen McTague?
MCTAGUE: Here, sir. I'm sorry I was late.
BASSICK: Be careful now, boys – we've got a tough job tonight!

Prepare to read one of the following monologues in addition to the scene above.

SHERLOCK: Suppose that since she knows nothing about this affair that we omit her name from the discussion. You see, you have already confessed. Every look, tone, gesture – everything you've said and done since I've been in this room has informed me that she never consented to this transaction. You see it's elementary, my dear Watson, elementary. The child's play of deduction.

MORIARTY: He has disappeared? Sherlock Holmes again. And now this bank job. He's in on that, too. And that's where he's made his mistake. Mr. Holmes is playing rather a dangerous game! Inspector Wilson tried it seven years ago. Wilson is dead. Two years later Henderson took it up. We haven't heard anything of Henderson lately, eh? (CHUCKLES) We have made sure of that!
